

# CAIRINE WILSON SS Course Selection Process -- 2017

## Step 1: **Grade Assemblies** (February 2<sup>nd</sup>)

- Review course options & graduation requirements
- Review the course selection process using the ***Career Cruising*** website
- Review where to find course info and descriptions
- Take the opportunity to ask questions of your teachers and guidance counsellors

## Step 2: **Go home and discuss your options with your parents**

- Review your credits earned so far (in ***Career Cruising's Course Planner***)
- Choose the courses you need/want to take
  - Senior students: use [www.electronicinfo.ca](http://www.electronicinfo.ca) and [www.ontariocolleges.ca](http://www.ontariocolleges.ca) to check post-secondary programs of interest and required pre-requisites for admission
  - all students can peruse the Careers section of ***Career Cruising***

## Step 3: **Choose your courses via Career Cruising (DEADLINE: Tuesday, February, 28)**

### **Step-by-step Instructions for Course Selection via Career Cruising:**

1. Go to: [www.ocdsb.ca](http://www.ocdsb.ca) > students > Career Cruising > Career Cruising Login
2. At the CC login page, view the ccPathfinder video. Also notice the Student Course Guide at the bottom of the page for referencing course descriptions.
3. Log in using the values requested. A personalized Access Card has been provided.
4. You may be prompted to set a new password, add your email, and accept terms of use before proceeding.
5. Once logged in, select: “**Choose My Courses**” from the menu list on the left-side.
6. Selections are saved and can be edited until the submit button is clicked. Once you submit, you will not be able to change your selections until June via a meeting with Guidance.
7. Print and sign the 4-page COURSE REQUEST SIGN OFF SHEET (note the additional signatures required for Media Permission Form and Appropriate Use of Technology Agreement.)
8. Return all printed and signed forms to STUDENT SERVICES by FEB. 28<sup>th</sup>
  - 4 sheets signed and stapled (printed from Career Cruising)
    - Course Request Sign Off Sheet (1 page)
    - Parent Authorization Forms (2 pages)
    - Media Permission Form (1 page)
