Safety:

Safety is a lens that is applied to physical situations, social interactions, and emotional states of being.

Below are 3 different tools that are used by OCDSB schools for immediate student safety and/or maintaining privacy. The first two tools can be used quite frequently for different situations that arise. We will be holding traditional fire drills and lockdown drills again

- Shelter in Place: A situation outside the school building (i.e. extreme weather, potentially dangerous wildlife, environmental situation...)
- Secure School: There is no immediate danger to persons in the school, however there is a need to contain the movement of persons within the school e.g. (e.g., medical emergency, transit of a student for privacy...)
- Lockdown: An active threat to the safety of persons in the school.*If a lockdown occurs the Ottawa Police Services takes temporary authority of the school.

Pedagogy:

- Destreaming: Last year only grade 9 math was de-streamed. This year All of grade 9 classes are now de-streamed. Grade 10 Math is Destreamed.
- We are developing a school based with district Leads to help support CWSS with destreaming. This will be once a month full day training.
- Derek B. posed a question regarding the voluntary student fees (\$35) a short discussion was held re: what the money is used for student generated fund account, specific rules regarding its use, supports for different areas in the school, for example, students in need snacks.
