### 1. Financial Report

- Marcia reported that School Council has \$1014.19 with \$1019.35 in reserve for planned expenditures. Additionally, funds have been received for the craft fair in the amount of \$6685
- One request was made for some funds from those in reserve for prom. While support was not needed for tickets, a request was made for \$65 to cover taxi fees for one student. All were in favour of providing the funds.
